BALLSTON SPA FILM FESTIVAL ANNOUNCES CELEBRITY JUDGES

The 4th annual Ballston Spa (International) Film Festival (BSFF) is ready to kick off another exciting year of short films from around the world and around the neighborhood. Judged by Hollywood professionals, the festival will be held in downtown Ballston Spa on August 4th-6th, with films screening at Wiswall Park and the Ballston Spa High School Auditorium. Admission is FREE and open to the public.

This year's judges include:

 both shot in the Capital Region and Ballston Spa. She is the production director at Time
 Warner Cable and directs and produces local TV commercials. This is her fourth year

- Larry Jackson Jackson was the Executive in Charge of Production for Mystic Pizza
 and Silence of the Lambs. He directed Bugs Bunny Superstar, helped plan Robert
 Redford's Sundance Institute and was Executive VP at Miramax Films. This is his
 second year judging BSFF.

Forty-one films (including entries from Mexico, England, Poland, Australia, Argentina, Spain, Russia, India, Germany, New York, California, and the Capital District) will be screened this year and include submissions from Aardman Animation (*Wallace & Grommet*), 2011 Oscar nominee, *The Gruffalo*, and actors like Helena Bonham Carter, John Hurt, Paul Sorvino, Michael Sorvino, and William Sadler.

In addition to the screenings, other festival events include fire dancers, a film editing workshop, director discussions, after parties, and music by Vesper and Billboard recording artist, Patti Rothberg.
